**RE: Impact to Supply and Risk Assessment of the Wuhan Coronavirus**

We understand and respect recently-expressed concerns regarding the potential impacts to supply that the 2019-nCov Coronavirus might create. We have been monitoring the fast-moving situation in China and elsewhere, and we are in daily contact with our suppliers and logistics providers to ensure that we continue to anticipate and adapt to potential future developments.

IronRidge and QuickMount rely upon a worldwide network of suppliers, including in the USA, to help us to manufacture and deliver our products. Our supplier network is architected to allow us to obtain the same products and assemblies from more than one source, thereby building inherent resilience into our supply base to accommodate disruptions in one particular part of our worldwide supply chain. Consequently we do not expect any material impacts to the availability of our products to meet our customers' and distribution partners' forecasted needs. Additionally, we do not currently have any new products in the pipeline whose availability to our customers and partners will be impacted by the spread of the Coronavirus.

As with any situation as dynamic as the one the world is currently facing, we will remain proactive and vigilant in monitoring the evolving situation, taking pre-emptive and adaptive measures as necessary, and advising our customers and partners of any material changes that may impact our supplies.
